Monroe County's ONLY community-based, 24/7 walk-in substance use addiction clinic. No appointments necessary!

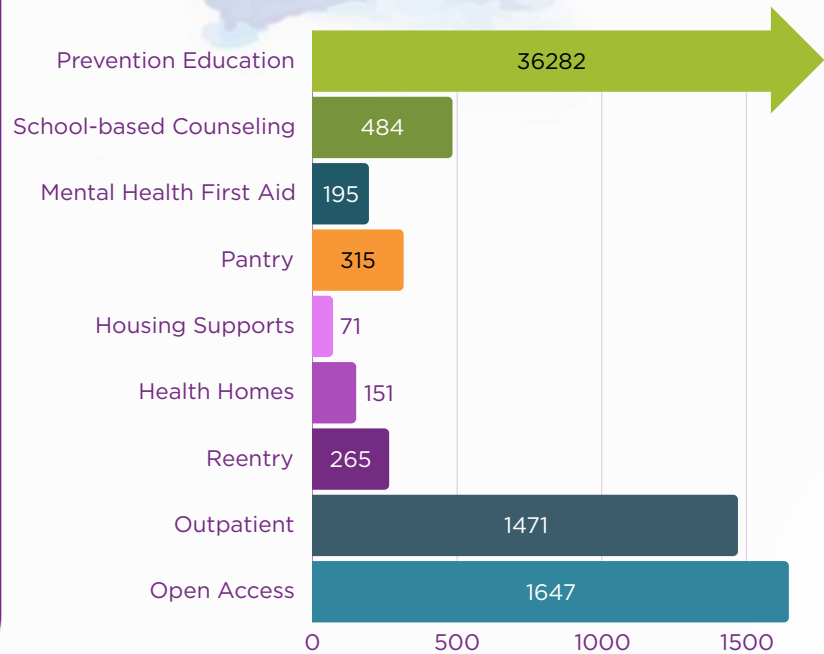

- **Belonging** → We foster connection and create spaces where everyone feels valued, included and supported.

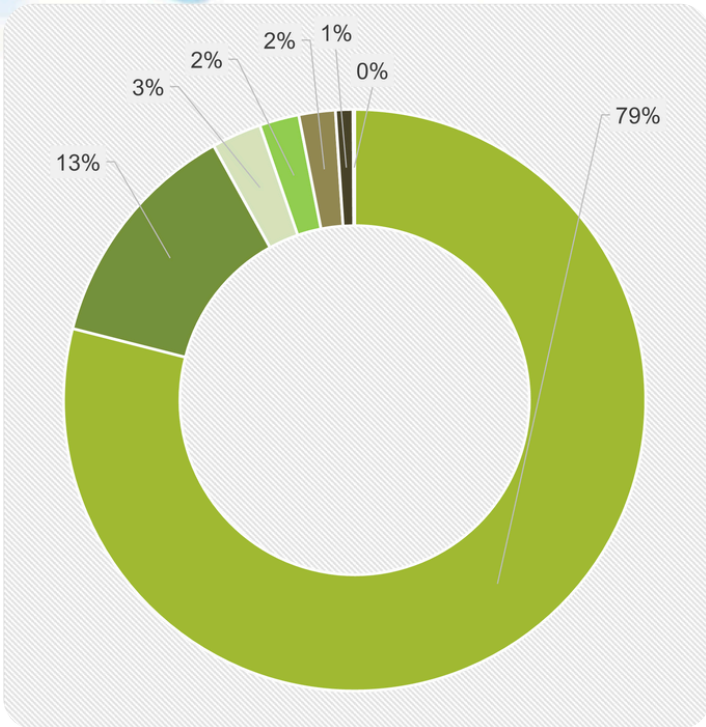

Year ending December 31, 2024

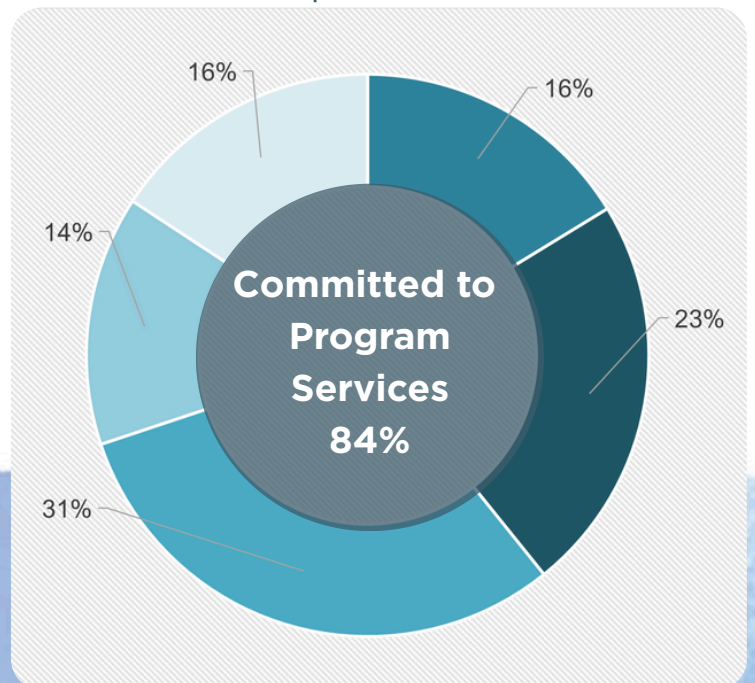
